• **Team Manager Agreement**

• **Team Size**

Each team must consist of exactly five members: Minimum 3 and maximum 5 members allowed.

• **Leadership & Membership**

Each team must perform with a unique team name and have one team leader and three team members.

• **Submission Process**

Only the team leader should fill out the registration form, ensuring all required student information for the team members are provided.

• **Respectful Disputes**

Each participant and any supervisor can not represent the college team.

• **Student Code**

Each member allowed to enter must be able to show student status when the event registration is required.

Competition Guidelines

GENERAL RULES

- Only the codes that are provided in the program and electronic challenges may be entered throughout the entire competition.
